From food security to mental health to safety, nonprofits joined forces and coordinated efforts to assist as many people as possible. They worked tirelessly, in some cases around the clock, to feed, house, and protect our neighbors.

And it wasn't just organizations meeting basic needs. Countless local nonprofits found creative ways to deliv-

er their programs to help our lives feel more "normal" and begin the process of recovery. Arts organizations delivered classes virtually. Theatre and music productions moved outside. Recreational groups made sure everyone had access to fresh air and exercise. By the fall of 2020, the entire nonprofit community had activated and contributed to our collective resilience.

And, through it all, the Community Foundation of the Gunnison Valley focused on providing support the nonprofit community relies on to deliver their services and programs.

We celebrate the 100+ nonprofits that continue to make recovery possible and the many community partners who are working every day to make the Gunnison Valley more resilient. We are blessed to live in such a wonderful place where people come together to support each other when our community needs it most.

Rallying to Respond..and Recover

CFGV's Gunnison Valley COVID-19 Recovery Fund provides critical assistance

When the pandemic hit Gunnison County hard in early 2020, the Community Foundation immediately recognized the need to provide a funding mechanism to support the increased needs in the community. The Gunnison Valley COVID-19 Recovery Fund was established in March to aid in response and recovery efforts.

Special thanks to the Rocky Mountain Health Foundation, the Gunnison Valley Regional Housing Authority, and the City of Gunnison for their partnership with the Gunnison Valley COVID-19 Recovery Fund.

GUNNISON VALLEY COVID-19 RECOVERY FUND GRANTS

CENTER FOR MENTAL HEALTH - \$10,000

Provide counseling for people who have lost their jobs or don't have access through health insurance

CITY OF GUNNISON - \$28,089

Provide free meals to local seniors through the Senior Meals program through December (part of Emergency Food Network grant)

CRESTED BUTTE FILM FESTIVAL - \$1,500

Help make the film, LIV, and panel discussion on suicide available to the public for free

CRESTED BUTTE STATE OF MIND - \$10,000

Provide teletherapy to help address the rising demand for mental health services, and provide therapy session scholarships for community members needing support

CRYSTAL RIVER VALLEY NONPROFIT FOOD CO-OP - \$3,000

Expand Marble Charter School's food program for kids in need to those children's families, making fresh, local produce and nutritious meals available

GUNNISON ARTS CENTER - \$5,000

Work with the Center for Mental Health to develop and administer a collection of art classes and activities that will help participants understand their emotions and learn new tools and techniques for coping and moving forward

GUNNISON COUNTRY FOOD PANTRY - \$17,900

Provide food for urgently needed relief

in Somerset, CO (\$1,000); continue meeting the growing need to help feed hungry families countywide (\$2,000); provide seven kid-friendly suppers each week to 50 families in extreme poverty (\$2,400); for the Emergency Food Network to advertise details of food opportunities (\$3,500); help with the purchase of a new free-standing walk-in freezer (part of Emergency Food Network grant) (\$9,000)

GUNNISON COUNTY HEALTH & HUMAN SERVICES - \$54,500

Assist local individuals and families with rent, utilities, and other basic needs (three awards were made possible through partnerships with the Gunnison Valley Regional Housing Authority and the Rocky Mountain Health Foundation) (\$41,000); provide 15,000 surgical face masks to meet safety and protection needs for front-line medical staff and volunteers (\$7,500); provide grocery store gift cards for low-income individuals and families whose food benefits have been expended (part of Emergency Food Network grant) (\$1,000); for emergency childcare needs made possible by the City of Gunnison (\$5,000)

GUNNISON COUNTY SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION PROJECT - \$5,000

For a peer-developed program to offer young people who request it access to two free, confidential wellness sessions with a mental health provider

GUNNISON HINSDALE EARLY CHILDHOOD COUNCIL - \$20,950

Provide coverage for sick leave for local daycare/preschool staff who

do not have access to paid sick leave (\$11,000); provide scholarship and tuition assistance (made possible by the City of Gunnison) (\$9,950)

GUNNISON VALLEY ANIMAL WELFARE LEAGUE - \$3,000

Provide pet supplies, shelter, veterinary care and spay/neuter assistance for those impacted by COVID-19

GUNNISON VALLEY HEALTH - \$15,976

Connect isolated Senior Care Center residents with loved ones via iPads and to increase community access to the Hospital's Peer Support Specialists for folks struggling with mental health, psychological trauma or substance abuse (\$6,700); provide mental health resources to Senior Care Center residents who have been isolated in their rooms (\$3,276); provide meals to our community's lowest-income senior citizens in partnership with the City of Gunnison Senior Center (\$4,000)

GUNNISON VALLEY MENTORS - \$4,000

Provide remote mental health services for at-risk youth while isolated at home

GUNNISON WATERSHED SCHOOL DISTRICT - \$10,500

Continue providing daily breakfast and lunch to local school children (\$4,000); provide scholarship and tuition assistance at Lake School made possible by the City of Gunnison (\$6,500)

GUNNISON & CRESTED BUTTE FARMERS MARKETS - \$900

Provide Double-Up bucks to match Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits at both farm-

ers markets (part of Emergency Food Network grant)

HISPANIC AFFAIRS PROJECT - \$18,000

For rent, utilities or other basic needs of Gunnison County immigrants who have lost their jobs and do not have access to unemployment or federal stimulus monies (two awards were made possible in partnership with the Gunnison Valley Regional Housing Authority and the Rocky Mountain Health Foundation)

KBUT COMMUNITY RADIO - \$2,000

Provide on-air question-and-answer sessions with public health personnel to keep residents and visitors informed on the latest local COVID news

LIGHTHOUSE PREGNANCY CENTER - \$1,000

Purchase diapers, formula, and other needed supplies for low-income pregnant women and their newborns

LIVING JOURNEYS - \$11,960

Provide free food boxes and prepared meals for local cancer patients through December (part of Emergency Food Network grant)

MARBLE CHARTER SCHOOL - \$1,000

Provide food for low-income families in need of assistance in the Town of Marble

MOUNTAIN ROOTS FOOD PROJECT - \$42,561

Provide meals for the parents of school children who are receiving food on weekends (\$2,840); serve meals to families unable to make ends meet

because of the COVID crisis (\$5,670); provide food to those in need through pop-up markets in high-need neighborhoods and home delivery of fresh food boxes (\$10,000); continuation of Free Markets through October and fresh food boxes (part of Emergency Food Network grant) (\$24,051)

PROJECT HOPE OF THE GUNNISON VALLEY - \$4,500

Provide rental and utility assistance as well as shelter and transitional housing expenses for victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, and human trafficking

SEASONS SCHOOLHOUSE - \$2,500

Provide scholarship and tuition assistance (made possible by the City of Gunnison)

SIX POINTS EVALUATION & TRAINING - \$5,000

Meet the need for increased services for Six Points clients during the Coronavirus pandemic when group support and social interaction in the community are not available

TENDERFOOT CHILD & FAMILY DEVELOPMENT CENTER - \$10,000

Provide scholarship and tuition assistance made possible by the City of Gunnison

WESTERN COLORADO UNIVERSITY - \$5,000

Supply face coverings for 1,000+ students returning to campus for the Fall 2020 semester

RECOVERY FUNDS IN ACTION – EMERGENCY FOOD NETWORK

Food assistance quickly emerged as one of the greatest needs. Over a dozen local nonprofits and government agencies were delivering their own food security programs, and CFGV saw an opportunity to help convene these groups and encourage collaboration and shared resources to increase effectiveness. The Emergency Food Network was born!

Spearheaded by Mountain Roots Food Project and the Gunnison Country Food Pantry, the Emergency Food Network brought together the various groups working on food security and created a plan to deliver services in concert through the end of 2020. As a result, hundreds of people didn't have to choose between paying the utilities or providing enough food for their families.

Through the Gunnison Valley COVID-19 Recovery Fund, CFGV issued our largest grant to-date to the Emergency Food Network in August 2020, totaling \$75,000. During 2020, the Recovery Fund gave nearly \$294,000 to 26 nonprofit organizations providing the basic needs of food, shelter, health and safety to many of our community's most vulnerable neighbors.

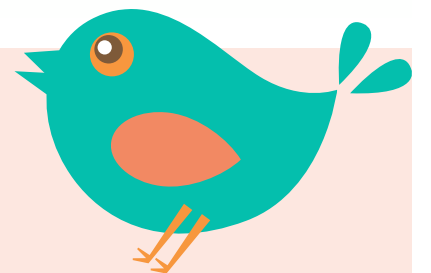

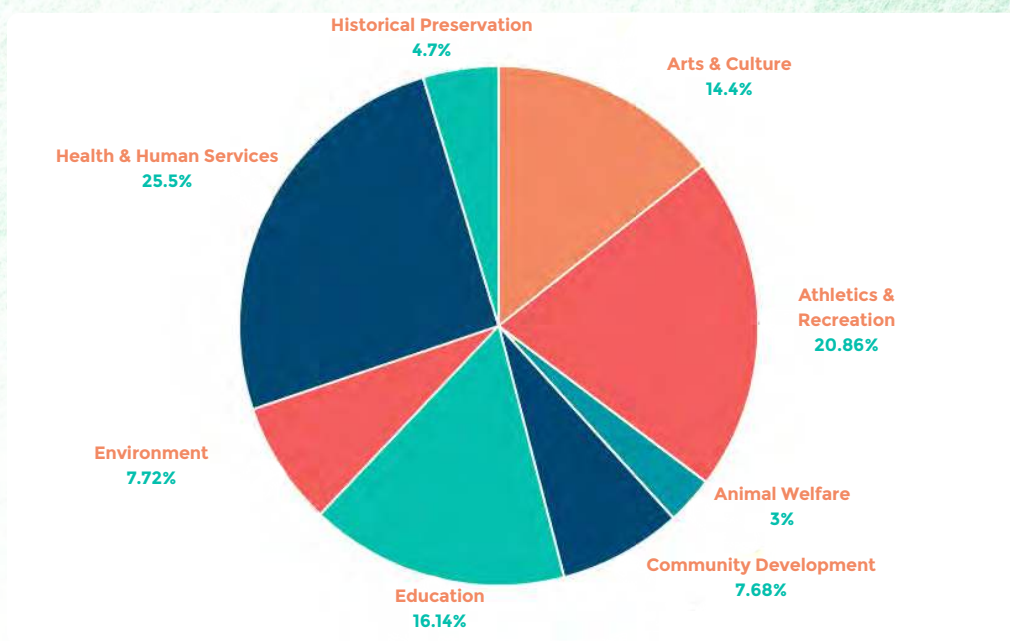

STORIES FROM 2020 COMMUNITY GRANTS RECIPIENTS



From Gunnison Country Food Pantry:

Jay is 73 years old and receives benefits from the State of Colorado to buy food he needs but has given up his driver's license due to diminished mobility. Emily tested positive for COVID-19 and was told to go straight home and isolate at least two weeks. Carmen has five children; her husband Jaime uses their car to work two jobs. What do these people have in common? They live on low incomes yet cannot get to the Pantry to ask for food assistance. Hardworking Pantry volunteers partnered with the Gunnison County Pandemic Response Team and Gunnison Valley Hospital Senior Transportation Services to deliver free food from the Pantry to households that need it.

From Living Journeys:

In April 2020, we learned that my husband, Charlie, had stage IV cancer. I was nervous, scared, and guarded when I reached out to Living Journeys. I have never been in such a hard place in life and felt so welcomed by an absolute stranger. Julie instantly made me feel like we weren't alone and told me all the ways that Living Journeys could assist; she gave me hope. From meals to travel reimbursement to grants for therapy, Living Journeys has become a constant in our lives.

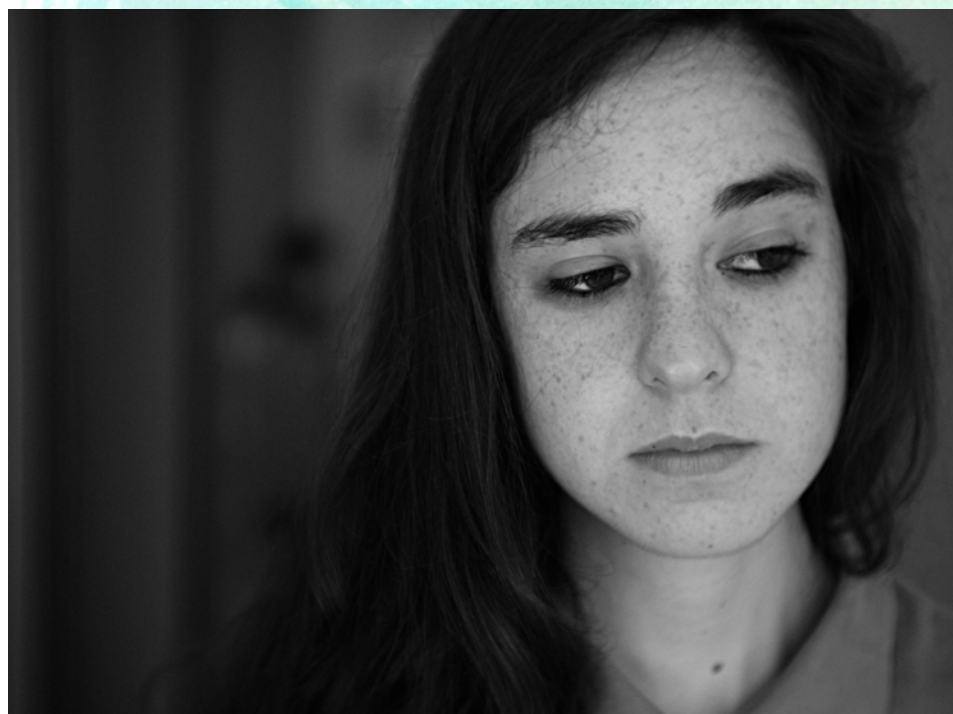
From Crested Butte Mountain Theatre:

The shuttering of businesses and enforced social restrictions seemed deeply personal to theatre groups around the world. Gathering people in close proximity is exactly what we do, after all. We uplift our community as individuals share their grief and joy and find love and fellowship. Though our stage was dark in 2020, our future shone bright. Our inboxes overflowed with "love-notes" from our audience, encouraging us to not give up, because they weren't giving up. We learned that we are essential to each other's livelihood - a generous reciprocity.



From Wonderland Nature School:

One of our scholarship recipients was the child of a struggling mom who couldn't work during COVID shutdowns and was experiencing a very difficult pregnancy. Her preschooler was able to stay in school where learning and routines remained stable and secure. This continuum of care and education is assisting mom with preparing her child for success in Kindergarten.



From Project Hope:

In the fall of 2019, Kay arrived in Gunnison with no support system and few material possessions. As a result of lifelong abuse, she suffered from a Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) and post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), a combination which made it difficult for her to be self-sufficient. Project Hope placed her in emergency shelter when she first arrived, and then moved her into a transitional housing unit. After a long search and a lot of leg work, Kay finally secured a safe, affordable place to live and is living on her own for the first time in many years.

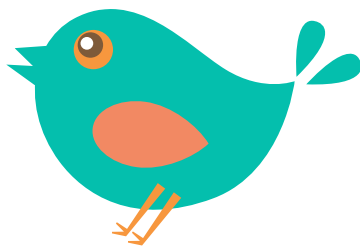
2008. She brings with her a fresh perspective and an appreciation of possibilities, and is excited to usher us into the next chapter.
